Drag racers to take over Brainerd's Westgate Mall August 12 for Fan Fest



More than 30 drag racers who will be racing Aug. 13-16 during the 2009 Lucas Oil NHRA Nationals at Brainerd International Raceway will be at Westgate Mall from 4-7 pm, Wednesday, Aug. 12 in Brainerd. Westgate Mall is

located on Hwy 210 just east of Hwy 371 in Baxter.

It's the 4th Annual Westgate Mall Fan Fest, which is free and open to the public. It's also a fundraiser for Brainerd Community Action, which supports a number of non-profit groups in the Brainerd area.
